
# What we are missing about the spiritually lost marriage prep couple

1. They don't choose to live by Catholic morality.

2. They don't understand or believe Catholic teaching.

3. They generally aren't seeking marriage in the Church for the "right reasons".



### WHAT WE ARE MISSING

- 1. We think they should "know better" or have intentionally chosen to reject our morality.
- 2. We believe that if they knew Catholic teaching better it would lead them to act differently.
- 3. We hope they will come to the "right reasons" for being married in the Church through catechesis.

The reason so much of the Church's moral teaching falls on deaf ears in our time is because it makes no sense according to the ruling vision of the society.

As long as that vision holds sway in an individual mind, teaching about moral truth (except where Christian moral precepts line up with those of the ruling vision) will be ineffective and will produce either bewilderment or anger."


## DENIAL OF THE FALL

#### **STAGE 1 - WITNESS**

#### Pre-Evangelization

Witness amongst people of the new and Christian way of being and living, including dialogue and charity. ([47]-[48] GDC). By word and deed.

#### STAGE 2 - PROCLAIM

#### **Initial Evangelization**

First or primary (explicit) proclamation of the Gospel (the Kerygma) and the call to conversion. ([47]-[48], [51], [61] GDC)

#### **STAGE 3 - CONVERT**

#### **Initial Conversion**

"Initial" conversion to Jesus Christ and becoming His disciple. Involves a change of life (metanoia), a profound transformation of mind and heart, and a "permanent commitment" to think, judge, and live like Christ. ([53], [55]-[56] GDC)

#### STAGE 4 - CATECHESIZE

#### **Initiatory Catechesis**


- "[I]nitial catechetical activity for those who choose the Gospel and for those who need to complete or modify their initiation." ([49] GDC)
- Conversion as pre-condition of fruitful catechesis. ([61]-[62] GDC)
- Characteristics: (1) A comprehensive and systematic formation in the faith; (2) An apprenticeship of the entire Christian life; (3) A "complete Christian initiation" which promotes an authentic following of Christ; (4) A basic and essential formation centered on what constitutes the nucleus of Christian experience. ([67] GDC)

#### **STAGE 5 - ADHERE**

#### Adherence

- Adhering to Christ. Continuing and Life-long conversion. Grow and change from child into the "perfect man", to maturity in the fullness of Christ. ([56] GDC)
- Led by the Spirit, progressing incrementally from purgative way of beginners, to illuminative way of proficients, to unitive way of the perfect.
- Growing in theological and cardinal (and other) virtues. Avoiding sin, removing vices, detachment & proper stewardship of material possessions. Cruciformity. Universal call to holiness.
- Abiding in and with Christ daily in His Word and in prayer. Loving and receiving frequently
  the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist (source & summit). Devoted to our Lady.
- Evidenced by good works & fruits of the Spirit, especially love of God, Church and neighbor. A
  person of the Beatitudes.

## CONVERSION

... what is needed is the sort of intellectual life that was characteristic of the Church in her early centuries, a life possessed to some degree by every Christian.

It is not simply or primarily a matter of college degrees but of the conversion of the mind to a Christian vision of reality and of readiness to live out the ramifications of that vision.

## CONVERSION

Those who were brought into the Church in apostolic times **did more** than embrace a set of moral principles or doctrinal statements.

There was a need for a profound conversion of mind and imagination such as they saw everything differently.

## How to build TRUST

Delight in them

Avoid defensiveness and judgement

## How to create CURIOSITY

Speak the name of Jesus Ask questions about their beliefs Tell stories - Jesus stories Match their level of curiosity AVOID apologetics, focus on Jesus **TESTIMONY!!!** 

## How to create **OPENNESS**

Intercession Break the silence Ask thought provoking questions "connect the dots" for them Ask for a sign Pray with them
