- Lay Leaders




Why is this so important NOW?

Where are we?

- Cultural unrest
- Political division
- Confusion and division in the Church
- Dealing with a pandemic
- A transition of eras

Where are we going?

- We are mobilizing for apostolic mission
- We are leaving the familiar behind
- We are led by deep prayer and discernment
- The path is never fully revealed





What is an Apostolic Mindset?

An apostolic mindset means that as individual disciples and as a Church, we:

- Have a **unique calling** from the Father,
- We are willing to open ourselves to a costly imitation of Christ,
- Have an utter reliance on the Holy Spirit,
- Need to be convicted of the primacy and power of the Gospel, and
- Are a joyfully countercultural witness.

We have no expectation that Christian values or authority exist anymore in the broader culture.

And we assume nothing with respect to their adoption or relevance.



HOWEVER...

What is an Apostolic Mindset?

We reject the temptations to either "hunker down" and wait out the bad times or capitulate to the world's demands.

Instead, we have a bold and radical willingness to risk for the sake of the Gospel, in hope, and are unafraid of persecution.

"In the world you will have trouble but take courage, I have conquered the world." - John 16:33



What Does This Mean For Me?

Institutional credibility is at all time low; not just the Catholic Church.

Parishes and Schools is where 1:1 relationships are built and supported among the faithful.

The faithful are the ones who GO OUT to those in need of the Good News.

The overarching goal of the Pastoral Center is to continue to make parish and school "maintenance" easier, in order to make "mission" fruitful.


