Parish Operations Management System (POMS)

Overview

POMS is a database application that maintains key parish information, is web accessible, and is of value to priests, parish staff, and AoD personnel.

Disaster Recovery Plan

Have a plan that includes:

- Emergency contact information.
- Important vendor contact numbers.
- Addresses of parish, school and any other buildings.
- Identify critical systems hardware and software.
- Include steps to bring them back online in case of a disaster.
 - Restore from backup.
 - Cloud apps.
 - Reinstall from CD or other media.



Data Security

Prevent attacks using technology

- Internet provider firewall.
- Software virus protection and malware protection.
- Windows operating system updates
 - Windows server 2012 and newer is supported.
 - Windows 7 is unsupported.
 - Tech Soup discount source for non-profit software.
 - Windows 11 is coming.



Data Security

Prevent attacks with informed employees

- Be suspicious of emails from unknown senders.
- Don't click on links unless you know the website.
- Use caution if ever asked for a username/password.
- Have different password for different sites and change passwords frequently.
- Employ a password manager, encrypted file or even notebook.
- Multi-Factor authentication



Microsoft Licenses for non-profits

Microsoft offers great non-profit pricing

- Free Faculty and Student MS Office licenses
 - Includes full suite of Office products Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneDrive Teams, etc.
 - Web use only
 - Ability to personalize the web domain in the email system which allows email addresses to be customized per Parish/school
 - Examples:

Business Manager Email

What?

New email address issued to each business manager.

Why?

- To improve communication with the Archdiocese
- To retain important historical data
- To keep email secure
- To allow logins to future systems
- To give secure cloud storage
