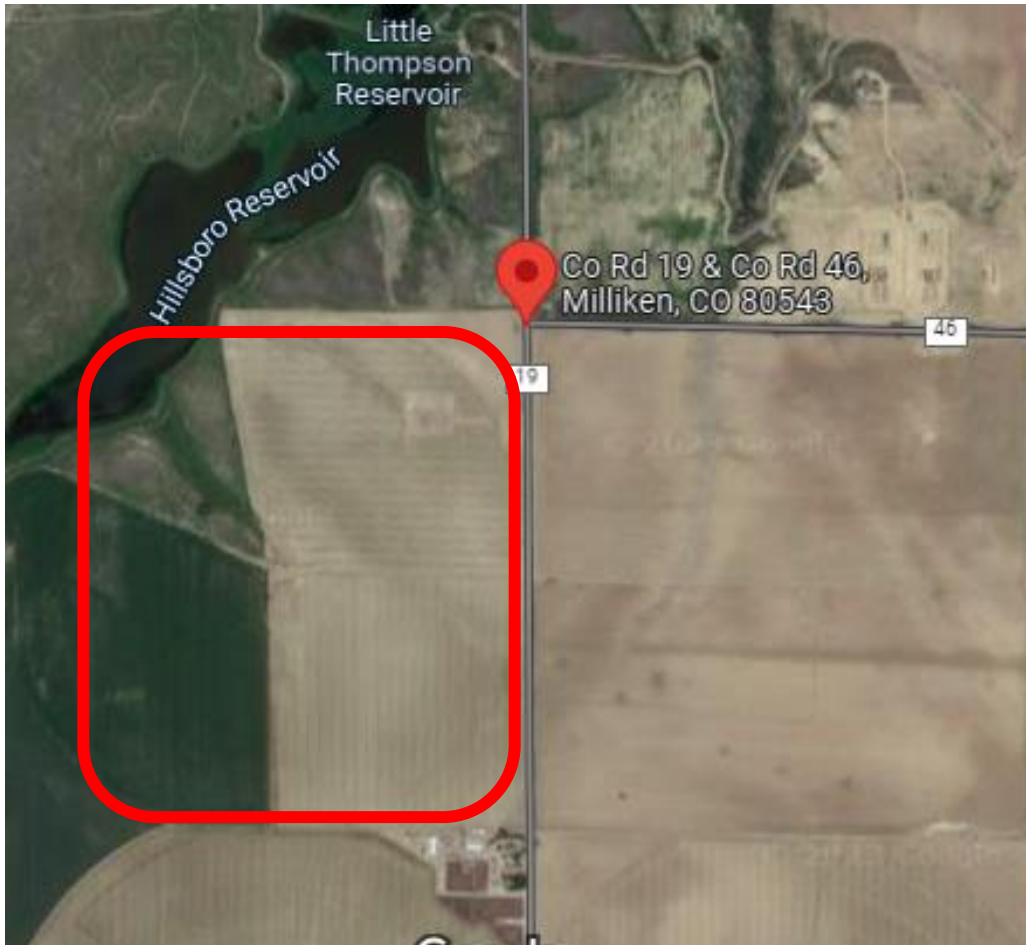


Archdiocesan Community Solar Project

WHAT IS COMMUNITY SOLAR?



- 80 Acres of Archdiocesan owned land
- Located at corner of County Road 19 and 46 in Weld County



1. GARDEN HARNESSSES SOLAR ENERGY

Solar panels located on Archdiocesan land outside of Johnstown will harness energy from the sun.

2. GARDEN DELIVERS ENERGY ONTO UTILITY GRID

The energy generated by the solar garden is distributed onto your utility's grid, supplementing their power supply with clean, renewable solar energy.

3. UTILITY CONTINUES TO POWER YOUR CHURCH OR SCHOOL

Your utility provider continues to deliver power to your church, rectory, or school.

4. RECEIVE CREDITS FROM UTILITY

The bill credit amount you receive from the utility will be based on your meter type. R, C, or SG meters are eligible to participate.

5. RECEIVE BILL FROM SUNSHARE

SunShare, the partner selected by the Archdiocese to build the solar garden, will send you a monthly bill that reflects the amount of solar energy your subscription produced on your behalf. For R and C meter types, your SunShare bill will always be 10% less than the bill credits generated by the utility. For an SG meter type, your SunShare rate will start at 5% less than the bill credit rate, and will never be more than your total bill credits.

How to Sign Up for the Archdiocesan Community Solar Project

Step 1

Complete Consent to Disclose Utility Customer Data Form to allow SunShare to calculate the amount of solar subscription needed and savings based on historic electric usage. (This usually takes 4-8 Weeks depending on Xcel's response time).



Step 2

After reviewing savings, sign three additional subscription documents.

These documents allow SunShare to provide the credit on the utility bill. This usually takes less than a week. The goal is by May 24, the 8th Anniversary of Laudato Si!

Step 3

You will begin receiving bill credits when the community solar garden is energized, which is currently targeted for December of 2023. SunShare will send you communications about onboarding and timelines while the solar garden is being constructed.

Xcel Energy's standard report of Customer Energy Usage Data contains monthly usage information. Depending on the type of utility meter installed at your premise, Xcel Energy might be able to provide more granular (daily) Customer Energy Usage Data, and/or information about total energy use in each billing period, average energy use per day, and measured and billed demand.

In addition to the Customer Energy Usage Data described above, the report we receive from Xcel Energy will also include your: name; account number; service number; meter number; utility type; service address; premise number; premise description; meter read date(s); number of days in the billing period; utility invoice date; base rate bill amount; other charges including base rate and non-base rate adjustments; taxes, and invoice total amount.

Exclusion: Xcel will not provide us with your Social Security Number or any financial account number.

CUSTOMER'S CONSENT
 Your information is treated as private by Xcel Energy. You are not required to authorize the disclosure of your information, and your decision not to authorize the disclosure will not affect your utility services. Note that Xcel Energy will have no control over the information disclosed pursuant to this consent, and will not be responsible for monitoring or taking any steps to ensure that the information recipient maintains the confidentiality of the information or uses it as authorized by you.

By signing this form you acknowledge and agree that you are the customer of record for this account and that you authorize Xcel Energy to disclose your information as specified in this form. Q: What Makes Me Eligible for This Project

A: Must Have Xcel Electricity

Q: What happens if more or less electricity is used in the future at my property?

A: Extra credits can be shifted to other AoD accounts

Q: Do I have to worry or pay to maintain the solar garden?

A: No, the garden is maintained by SunShare

Q: Is this too good to be true? I heard natural gas had a big charge from suppliers after the 2021 Feb. freeze?

A: The account is still with Xcel not a 3rd party supplier and credit regulated by the State of Colorado.
