Trust	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Positive association with Church, Christian, Jesus etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Identify if bridge of trust exists and what it is -Work to build a bridge if it is not there -Be a friend- invest in a relationship -Avoid defensiveness and judgement -Make and keep promises -Listen to their story 	
Curiosity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Desire to know more about Jesus - Intrigued by Christian things - Not open to change 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Speak the name of Jesus -Ask questions -Tell stories- Jesus story- Christian's stories -Match their level of curiosity -Avoid apologetics- focus on Jesus -Testimony 	
Openness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Acknowledgement of openness to change -Triggered by major life events 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Intercession -Break the silence -Ask thought provoking questions -Connect the dots -Ask for a sign -Pray with them -Adoration -Patience in the process 	
Seeking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Actively seeking to know Jesus -Desires to know whether they can commit to Jesus and His Church -Greater intentionality -Weighing the cost of discipleship -Increase awareness of personal sin 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Confession -Expose them to the diversity of prayer and tradition -Kerygma -Introduce them to other disciples -Model Christian life- the ups and downs -Testimonies -Focus on Jesus -Evangelistic opportunities- retreats, Alpha, Discovery 	
Intentional Disciple	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Clear decision to follow Jesus - Changed life 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Supportive Christian community - Ask if they are ready to make the choice - Invite them where the Kerygma will be shared, and they will be invited to respond - Intercessory prayer - Celebration 	

Disciple's Growth in Holiness

Framework	Indicator	Tool	Notes
Beginning (Infant)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Go to mass regularly -Trying daily prayer and sharing about what God is doing in prayer life -Excitement about what God is doing in their life -Avoiding temptations -Making efforts to connect to a community -Attend formation opportunities -Ask questions about church teaching -More comfortable using Jesus' name 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Source and Growth - Formation in the Sacraments - Help them learn to pray - Scripture reading - Prayer journal - Testimony 	
Growing (Adolescent)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Desire greater intimacy with Jesus - Articulate how the Lord is speaking to them personally - Fruits of the spirit are manifested - They trust the Magisterium - Their character is not dependent on their environment - Increase fervour in holiness & mission - Look beyond themselves to the needs of others - Self-motivated in prayer - Attend reconciliation regularly - Seeking spiritual direction - Spiritual reading 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Encourage greater docility to the Holy Spirit and acceptance of the gifts of the Spirit - Encourage them to grow towards 1 hour of personal prayer in 10-minute increments - Encourage Bible reading as a part of prayer - Trust & Commission - Discernment tools - Good books 	
Maturing (Adult)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Deep and intimate relationship with Jesus - Seek sacraments and prayer - Personal responsibility for growth - Independent in searching for greater intimacy with God - Resourceful in finding new ways to deepen relationship with God - Consistent in prayer

Framework	Indicator	Tool	Notes
Witness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Open about faith - Share testimony - Inviting others to mass or events - Admit openly to being a Christian - Witness through the way they live their lives. - Showing signs of discontent that people don't know God personally - Can articulate the Gospel - Are intentionally building relationships - Inviting others to events or activities where the Gospel will be proclaimed - Seeking to help in ministry 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Equip with attitudes, skills and knowledge to transition to proclaiming and having a heart for the lost - Intercede with them - Invite them to take responsibility in small tasks - Encourage them to invite friends to Mass or events - Prepare a testimony 	
Proclaim	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Inviting others to put Jesus at the center of their lives - Share the Kerygma- Discovery or Ultimate Relationship - Desire to see people commit to Jesus - Understand their missionary identity - Have a heart for the lost - Have an awareness of what God is doing in the lives of their Timothies - Burning desire to see others come to know Jesus 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Equip with attitudes, skills and knowledge to transition and multiply others. - Train them to share the Kerygma- use the Ultimate Relationship - Get them leading a Discovery - Make an impact list with them - Teach them the IA framework - Teach them about spiritual multiplication 	
Multiply	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Have Timothies who have Timothies - Equipping others for the mission- to witness and proclaim - Training others to lead Faith Studies - Train others to share the Gospel - They become co-laborers - They can identify a spiritual legacy or chain 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ask questions and offer directions for their support of others - Refer to the tools from previous phases to help them identify what to do with their people
